

## My favorite holiday recipe

Christmas is my favorite holiday to celebrate with my family, although having a large family with multiple places to celebrate can quickly become stressful when deciding what dish to bring so I love to make a quick dessert that is low maintenance so my children can help make and enjoy it as well. We love how easy and delicious "Heavenly Oreo Dessert" is.

First you will need to place all of the Oreo cookies into a large zip-lock bag. Seal the bag shut and crush the cookies until they are small crumbs. Set aside 1/3 of the cookie crumbs for the topping. Pour the remaining cookie crumbs into a baking pan. Pour melted butter over the crumbs and mix well to combine. Once combined press the crumbs into the pan to form a crust.

In a bowl, mix the 2 pudding mixes and milk. Cover and place in the refrigerator to set.

In another bowl, blend the cream cheese until smooth, slowly add in the powdered sugar, add in one container of cool whip and spread the mixture over the cookie crust.

Finally, you will take the chocolate pudding and spread it over the cream cheese mixture. Spread the other container of cool whip over the chocolate pudding layer. Sprinkle the top with the remaining cookie crumbs and cover and chill in the fridge at least 2 hours before serving.

My children love this dessert and we have so much fun making it together.

The ingredients you will need:

1 package of Double stuffed Oreo cookies

1/2 cup of butter, melted

2 boxes of instant chocolate pudding mix

3 1/4 cups of cold milk

2 containers of Cool whip

1 block of cream cheese

1 cup of powdered sugar
